Charles D. Roth

LITTLETON — Charles D. Roth, 27, of 39 Mill Rd., died at his residence on June 1 after a lengthy illness. He was born in Mt. Kisco, New York, November 1, 1957, son of Charles and Betty (King) Roth. He had spent his early school years in Lincoln and later Littleton Schools, and graduated in the class of 1974.

Charles attended Mt. Wachusett Community College and received an Associate Degree in Plant Science and Horticulture from the University of Massachusetts. He worked as a florist at Webber's Conservatory in Littleton and Old Town Florist in West Palm Beach, Florida. He had made his home in Florida for three to four years and moved back to Littleton last July.

Mr. Roth had been active in 4-H Club where he was a Junior Leader, and raised goats for show. He was president of the Potpourri Planters and a member of the American Orchid Society.

His survivors include his parents, Charles and Betty (King) Roth of Littleton; a paternal grandmother, Mrs. C. Henry Roth of New Milford, Connecticut; a maternal grandmother, Mrs. James King of Danbury, Connecticut; a brother, Richard A. Roth of Groton; and two sisters, Barbara E.
