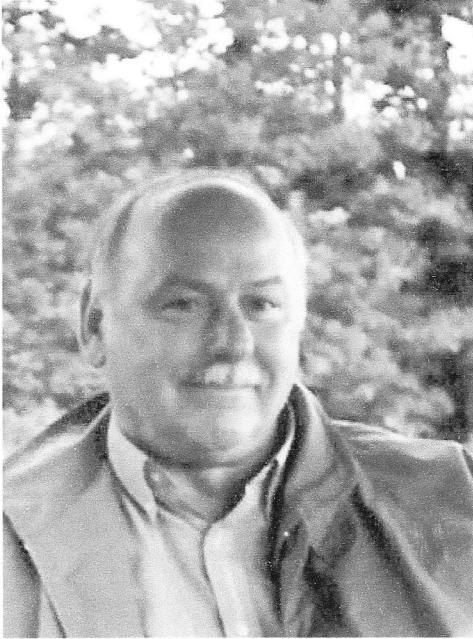


Alfred Jasins

Alfred Jasins, 71, died on June 12 at his residence after a brief illness. He was born in Gardner on October 2, 1938 son of the late John and Frances (Sklenis) Jasinskas. He grew up in Athol and was a graduate of Athol High School. In High School, Al was Class President and eventually went on to play at Brown University. While at Brown he majored in Physics.

Mr. Jasins worked for many years developing and selling scientific instruments. From 1968-1987, Al was founder and president of Jasins & Sayles Corp. who made scientific and medical devices. He held several patents and has written articles in scientific journals. After his business was sold, he bought and sold real estate and collecting and dealing art. He enjoyed a simple life where his family was most important. He was an excellent cook and enjoyed fishing and boating.

His survivors include his wife Elaine (Fleming) Jasins of Littleton, Father of John Jasins of San Francisco CA, and Alfred "Fred" Jasins of Cairo, Egypt. Brother of John Jasins of Athol, and Milda Jasins of Menlo Park CA. Also survived by several nieces and nephews.
