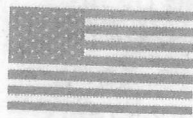


Ralph R. Lang, Jr.

loved his country, family and community

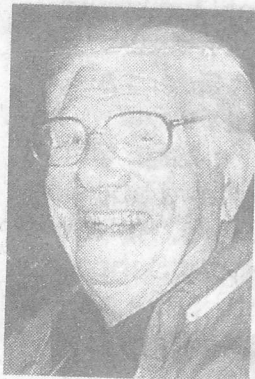
