
Lloyd Schultz

Lloyd Schultz, former resident of Littleton, died in Florida on July 31. He was 85.

Born in Providence, R.I., he graduated from Littleton High School in 1930. An artist and teacher by profession, he was educated at the Massachusetts College of Art and at the Institute of Design of the Illinois Institute of Technology.

From 1946-1949, he was the regional art teacher for the towns of Littleton, Harvard, Carlisle, Stow, and Bolton. He served as basketball and baseball coach for

the Littleton High School teams. His 1948 basketball team won a regional championship.

He taught at the Newton North High School in Newton from 1955-1977, when he retired as head of the art department. After his retirement, he moved to Nantucket where he lived for 10 years until failing health precipitated a move to Florida.

He leaves his wife, Rosalind Schultz, of Lake Mary, Fla.; a son, Eric Schultz of Nantucket; a daughter, Ingrid Schultz Adam of Shirley Center; and grandsons Nigel Goss and Geoffrey Schultz, also of Nantucket.
